JOIN 180'S DOMESTIC VIOLENCE RESPONSE TEAM (DVRT)

Volunteer Advocates are civilian members of the community who work collaboratively with law enforcement to provide confidential support to survivors of domestic violence at police headquarters. Advocates help to empower victims to make informed decisions for themselves and their families. The identities of the DVRT volunteers are kept anonymous. Prior knowledge of domestic violence is not required. 180 and the police departments are committed to culturally and socially diverse teams to better serve the community. Bi-lingual capability is helpful. Training will be provided free of charge to successful applicants.

REQUIREMENTS FOR VOLUNTEERS TO APPLY

- ✓ Must be 18+
- ✓ Attend monthly supervisory meetings via Zoom
- ✓ Be willing to serve on an on-call shift basis
- ✓ Have a valid driver's license and access to transportation
- ✓ Participate in an interview process that includes fingerprinting and a background check
- ✓ Successfully complete the mandatory 40-hour training via Zoom
